

ORDINANCE NO. 8-03/1-2016 AMENDED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALTO, TEXAS AMENDING THE TO DELETE THE EXISTING ARTICLE Chapter 9, Article IV., SECTION 9.31, DEFINITIONS, ii. A valid motor vehicle inspection certificate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALTO, TEXAS, THAT THE FORMER ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 9, SECTION 9.31, DEFINITIONS, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BE DELETED AND THE FOLLOWING ADOPTED IN ITS STEAD AND SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

CHAPTER 9

ARTICLE IV. JUNKED MOTOR VEHICLES

Section 9.30. Short Title

This article may be cited as "Junked Motor Vehicle Regulations."

Section 9.31. Definitions.

1. "Junked vehicle" means a vehicle that is self-propelled and:
 - a. Does not have lawfully attached to it:
 - i. An unexpired license plate; and
 - b. Is wrecked, dismantled or partially dismantled, or discarded; or
 - c. Inoperable and has remained inoperable for more than 45 consecutive days
2. "Antique vehicle" means a passenger car or truck that is at least twenty-five (25) years old
3. "Motor vehicle collector" means a person who;
 - a. Owns one or more antique or special interest vehicles; and
4. "Motor vehicle collector" means a person who:
 - a. Owns one or more antique or special interest vehicles; and
 - b. Acquires, collects, or disposes of an antique or special interest vehicle or part of an antique or special interest vehicle for personal use to restore and preserve an antique or special interest vehicle for historic interest.

** "Special interest vehicle" means a motor vehicle of any age that has not been changed from original manufacturer's specifications and, because of its historic interest, is being preserved by a hobbyist.
