"Any person who shall harbor or keep on his premises or in or about his premises under his control, any dog or animal of the canine species which, by loud or unusual barking or howling, shall cause the peace and quiet of the neighborhood or the occupants of adjacent premises to be disturbed or reasonably liable to be disturbed, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not exceeding Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars," and each and every twenty-four hour period that said dog shall remain or be kept on any such premises shall constitute a separate offense."
